The applications are judged on their service to community and school, response to essay questions, awards and honors, transcripts, and extracurricular activities. The committee will equally consider all candidates.

1. Eligibility

- a. Any graduating senior under 19 years old who attends the Blue Ridge School District
- b. Must be attending post-secondary education the fall following graduation
- c. Letter of enrollment must be received for scholarship to be paid

2. Criteria for Judging

- a. Completion of the Scholarship Application
- b. Community Service
- c. Transcripts
- d. Extracurricular activities
- e. Completion of 2 Essay Questions (double spaced, 12-point font)

3. Timelines

- a. Applications are due to the high school office by February 1st
- b. Winners will be notified at the annual school awards ceremony

4. Application process

- a. Chamber of Commerce board will evaluate each application
- b. Please complete the following application on page two. The essay question will need to be completed on an additional page. Make sure the following items are included: High School Transcript, Non-School Activities with dates and hours, School Activities with dates, Completed Application.
- c. Application should be typed or neatly printed.
